LOST

It is hard to admit how easily we get lost. We lose our way in the rush of tasks, meetings, and activities and get out of the habit of daily prayer, Sunday Mass, and service. We get caught up in the pursuit of material wealth, power, social status, and worldly success. We may be dismissive of people whose perspectives are different from our own. We become selfish and self-centered. We are blind to the needs of others, concerned solely with ourselves, our family, our small social circles. We get off track and for a while do not even realize we are lost. Like the young son in the parable, something has to happen to bring us back to our senses.

FOUND

The young son "hit bottom" and made his way home. The Israelites learned to trust in and follow God and entered the Promised Land. We are found the moment we realize we are lost and begin our journey back to the Lord. Jesus not only shows us the way, Christ is our way home to God. Our homeward path is often an examination of conscience, by which we search our hearts and recognize our failings. We may need to make amends to those whom we have hurt; we might be called to a change of attitude or behavior. Are you lost? Now is the perfect time to open your mind and heart, and admit that you have lost your way. Lent is a season when we admit the ways that we are missing the mark and return to God. Often, we do so through the sacrament of Reconciliation, in which we confess our sins, are given penance, and accept Christ's warm embrace of forgiveness.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners and Friends:

I wish all of our students and faculty members a very joyful and restful spring break. As you spend time with your families and friends, please do not forget to go to Church on Sunday and continue to observe the disciplines of lent: prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

As you well know, our Christmas raffle has been our only fundraiser since the pandemic broke out in 2019 with a profit of \$31,029.12 (2020), \$31,727.00 (2021) \$30,739.46 (2022) achieved by sponsoring raffle tickets, prizes, and selling tickets.

This year's attempt to plan a Fall Festival and recapture the magic of fellowship and big profit has fallen short. The Festival this past year netted a profit of \$30,114.64 less than our Christmas raffle from prior years. The festival also required a year's work of long commitments and hard work. Our parish is also experiencing a significant decrease in volunteers, contributions, sponsorships and manpower. In light of these challenges, the Pastoral Council met Wednesday, February 21st, 2024 and made the following decisions:

- There will not be a Fall festival this year.
- A major raffle will take place on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>December 25th, 2024 after the 11:00 morning mass</u>.
- A small fellowship will be organized in the fall which will include chicken plates, children's games and music.

In order for us to be successful this year each parishioner will receive 100 raffle tickets to sell for \$2.00 each. Please make a special effort to sell all your tickets and perhaps sell more. Knowing that this will be our only fundraiser this year, please be generous in supporting our parish and all the persons working for its success.

I highly encourage you to attend <u>daily mass</u> at 12:00 noon, <u>Sunday mass</u>, which is a day of obligation, <u>Holy Hour</u> every Thursday from 6:00 to 7:00 in the evening, <u>Stations of the Cross</u> every Friday at 6:00 in the evening and pray daily as a family. You are also encouraged to observe the discipline of Lent which includes prayer, fasting and almsgiving.
